157/22 TERRACYCLE

This is a project the Environmental Committee would like to get all Councillors involved using the local community centres in each ward to collect different items of recycling. Also something schools can also get involved with further down the line.

There are three terracycle public drop off points registered in Corby, Boots Opticians - ACUVUE® Contact Lens, Card Factory - Foil Balloons, corporation Street and Superdrug, Retail Park - Maybelline Makeup.

Stage 1 Officers to register with this project and find out which recycling requirements are open for collection on the Terracycle website.

Community centres – Disposable gloves, Nitrile gloves, Flash wipes, cloths and pads, Coffee caps, Crisp packets, confectionery packets. Pringles tubes, Warburtons bakery and wax wraps, RB Hygiene (Finish, Vanish packaging)

Stage 2 Find out which centres/school are keen to be take part, source collection boxes and look at the different methods of sending the recycling off Terracycle.
