124/22 PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

A member of the public present requests the council investigate the installation of dual recycling bins in and around Corby. It was discussed getting in touch with some of the larger businesses within the town who customers are responsible for some of the rubbish such as McDonalds could start the conversation off.

The recycling discussion also extended to the future premises of the Town Council as this could also double up as a recycling hub to accept the more unusual items recycled such as – printer cartridges, coffee machine pods and crisps packets etc. A recent news article was shared by Cllr Reuby where a schoolgirl has inspired a school project to clean and convert crisps packets into thermal blankets for the homeless.

125/22 BIG PIC – 19th to 25th SEPTEMBER IN CONJUNCTION WITH NNC

Cllr Dalziel shared the information discussed on a recent call with NNC – Safer Corby Team who are arranging the autumn litter pick in Corby in line with the national campaign. The Payback Team have agreed to carry out picks in 3 wards on Monday 19th, Tuesday 20th, and Wednesday 21st. The Council need to supply information of the 3 areas causing the most concern. It was agreed the Council will carry out their own pick on Thursday 22nd September 10am – 12pm around the Abbington Road Park location. This will be advertised via the usual social media channels and directly with some of the local businesses



discussed in item 124/22 whose customers have a direct influence on the amount of rubbish found, such as McDonalds.
