**193/23 UPDATE ON NNC WASTE SERVICES PROJECT 2024**

Tracey Montgomery from NNC wrote to us about the Waste Services project:  
*We are currently running a project with the Justice department to help address most items associated with antisocial behaviour. This includes, litter picking, graffiti removal and other jobs that do not take jobs away from the day jobs. If you have anything specific that requires attention I am happy to add them to our list. Jobs are allocated out on a weekly basis therefore we are unable to put a timescale on the works being carried out. They are though, once allocated dealt with the following week. Works required on private land would not generally be dealt with but its always worth raising as a query in case there are ways of addressing this.*

Terracycle offer a series of **free** recycling programmes linked to specific branded items supported by various companies.

However a series of “all-in-one” boxes that covers a wide range of items can be purchased.

These are available in the three stated dimensions priced between £92 and £199.

**Officers recommend members authorise the purchase of whichever box they feel is the easiest to manage with a view to a pilot project at the Beanfield Community Centre with a view to expansion elsewhere based on use.**
