487/22 MINUTES OF THE LAST MEETING

488/22 UPDATE ON RESTAURANT WEEK - 25th March – 2nd April 2023

The Officers updated the committee on the 13 restaurants who have signed up to the first restaurant week and AM discussed the BBC Northampton interview arranged for Wednesday 29th March from 7.20am with Cllr Reilly assisting with the first interview. It was suggested this event is follow up after its completed on its success and changes which can be made for the next restaurant week.

489/22 WORKERS MEMORIAL DAY – Saturday 29th April 2023

RR confirmed the theatre is free for this event and has been provisionally booked. Final details are required to complete the booking. The Council have agreed to pay £200 towards the theatre hire.



490/22 KINGS CORONATION – Sunday 7th May 2023

This event is being arranged by the Friends of Coronation Park and supported by the Event Officers. Next planning meeting arranged for 23rd March. The event starts at 12pm and they have a full programme of entertainment, stalls and street food in the park till 6pm.

The flyer designed by CTC have been sent to print but another organisation will meet the cost of these. The mayor has been booked to open the event and judge the children's dressing up competition. RR to produce a small programme for the day and certificates for the children taking part in the fancy dress.

491/22 PRIDE – Saturday 10th June 2023

The location for Pride has been agreed as Coronation Park and NNC have confirmed this can be used. The Officers are continuing to book all the elements required for the event and have arranged site meetings in the pavilion for the working group on the afternoon of Thursday 6th April. Sponsorship update - AM confirmed RS Components have agreed to be the main sponsor for the event with a £7,500 sponsorship package.

Wincanton have also agreed to a sponsorship package of £2,000 plus the use of their Proud Mary Truck and other give away products.

We also have £2,000 agreed from 2 other groups – Unite Union and The Foster Carers Society AM to follow up on other businesses as possible sponsors.
